Discussion on the UAS Data Protection Guidelines:

The UAS Data Protection Guidelines is part of the WFP UAS project that is funded by FCDO. It has been discussed within the team that it would be a great opportunity for the Ethics TWG to give their feedback since the mandate and the expertise that this group have is very similar to the subject matter of the document.

The document was presented in this session by Christos and members engaged in a discussion of the main principles presented in the document presenting different perspectives and personal experiences. For more details please follow the recording from minute 13:30 till end.

The following points are a summary of what was discussed:

- In ICRC's point of view and under section 2, point **a) Fair and legitimate processing**, the legal basis should be prioritized in the following manner:
 - o Public interest;
 - o Legitimate interest;
 - o Vital best Interest of the individuals.
 - o Consent.
- Discussion around how can sensitive data be removed in the data processing stage.
- Should the group define sensitive data for each operation as it is context dependent or should it come from the group as a step for operators to consider?
